M.Com. Admission 2026–27

M.Com Admission Circular No. 03/2025

In compliance with the applicable rules, regulations and admission guidelines of the University of Calcutta for the academic session 2026–27, Goenka College of Commerce and Business Administration invites applications from eligible candidates for admission to the M.Com. 1st Semester (2026–27) course.

Candidates are advised to carefully read the following instructions regarding eligibility, seat allotment and admission procedure.

1. Admission Schedule

The last date for completion of the admission process, including application, fee payment and submission/verification of documents, shall be 27th August, 2026 (up to 5.00 P.M).

Eligible candidates are required to complete all admission formalities within the prescribed schedule. No application or admission request shall be entertained after the notified deadline.

Interested candidates are required to fill in the following Google-form by **26.08.2026 (till 5.30 P.M.)** before coming to the College, GCC&BA on **27th August, 2026 at 12.30 P.M.** for spot admission/counseling.

2. Seat Allotment and Category of Applicants

As per the applicable University of Calcutta guidelines, the total intake capacity of the two-year Postgraduate course shall be divided as follows:

A. Overall distribution of seats

- 80% of the total intake capacity shall be earmarked for admission to the two-year PG Course.
- The remaining 20% of the total intake capacity shall be earmarked for Lateral Entry into the second year of the PG Course, subject to the applicable rules and availability of seats.

B. Distribution of the 80% seats earmarked for the two-year PG Course

Out of the 80% seats:

- 60% of the 80% seats shall be earmarked for Part-A candidates. Thus, Part-A shall constitute 48% of the total intake capacity. These seats shall be filled by eligible Current Year (2026) students of the University of Calcutta, subject to the applicable CCF/University of Calcutta rules and eligibility criteria.
- 40% of the 80% seats shall be earmarked for Part-B candidates. Thus, Part-B shall constitute 32% of the total intake capacity. These seats shall be filled by eligible candidates from the University of Calcutta as well as other eligible Universities, including candidates qualifying under the applicable CBCS/1+1+1 system, subject to the University of Calcutta's rules.

Accordingly, the broad distribution of the total intake shall be:

Conversion of Part B seats to Part A seats and vice Versa has been permitted by the University of Calcutta (vide letter from the Secretary, UCAC, CU dated 13.08.2026), but in no way, the reserved category eligible candidates will be deprived of vacant seats of their respective category, if they qualify in order of merit after admissible relaxation in marks.

3. Eligibility

Candidates must fulfil the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University of Calcutta for admission to the M.Com. programme for the academic session 2026–27.

Candidates applying under Part-A and Part-B shall be considered strictly according to the applicable University rules, academic qualifications and other eligibility requirements.

4. Merit and Admission

Admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit and eligibility, subject to the applicable University of Calcutta rules and the availability of seats in the respective category.

The reservation policy prescribed by the University of Calcutta and the Government of West Bengal, wherever applicable, shall be strictly followed.

If eligible candidates are not available in any prescribed category, vacant seats shall be dealt with in accordance with the applicable University of Calcutta admission rules and guidelines.

5. Application and Admission Fee

Candidates selected for admission shall be required to pay the prescribed admission fee of Rs. 925/- through **IMPS/NEFT** within the stipulated date and time.

6. Submission and Verification of Documents

Candidates provisionally selected for admission shall be required to produce the original documents along with one set of self-attested photocopies at the time of admission/verification.

The following documents shall ordinarily be required:

1. Mark sheets/certificates of all qualifying examinations.
2. Age Proof Certificate.
3. University Registration Certificate, wherever applicable.
4. Reserved Category Certificate, wherever applicable.
5. PWD Certificate, wherever applicable.
6. EWS Certificate, wherever applicable.
7. Online Application Form.
8. Admission/Payment Receipt.
9. Aadhaar Card or other prescribed identity proof.
10. Migration/Equivalence Certificate, wherever applicable.
11. Any other document prescribed by the University of Calcutta or the College.

Admission shall remain provisional until successful verification of all required documents and fulfilment of the applicable eligibility conditions.

7. Important Instructions

1. Candidates must carefully verify their eligibility before applying.
2. Candidates must strictly follow the admission schedule notified by the College.
3. Submission of an application does not guarantee admission.
4. Admission shall be subject to verification of original documents and fulfilment of all eligibility conditions.
5. Candidates must comply with all applicable University of Calcutta rules, regulations and admission guidelines.
6. The College reserves the right to cancel an admission if any information or document submitted by a candidate is found to be incorrect, false or misleading.
7. Candidates are advised to regularly check the College website/notice board for subsequent notifications regarding merit lists, counselling, admission and document verification.
